Guidelines for Writing Competition

Theme

Prizes will be given to winning entries in each category i.e. Hindi & English.

The participants must adhere to the following formatting standards:

- Font type: Times New Roman for English and Unicode for Hindi
- Font Size: 12
- Spacing between lines: Double
- Pages to be numbered
- Quotation to be given in italics
- Final number of words must be written at the end
